Seit ca. 40 Jahren, beweisen die Neurowissenschaftler, dass der Mensch dank der neurosensoriellen Funktionen aufrecht steht und, dass das neuromuskuläre Gedächtnis im rechten Parietallappen lokalisiert ist.

Über 20 Jahren ist bekannt, dass die Muskeln miteinander in Beziehung stehen und die funktionellen Wege der Faszien und die Änderungen der dichten Bestandteile der Faszien durch unregelmäßige Spannungen der Muskeln bestimmt werden. Das nennt man Faziengedächtnis. Die Haltung ist die Summe des somatosensoriellen und fascialen Gedächtnisses.

Das erste Mal werden in einem Kongress zwei Denkschulen sich gegenüber gestellt, die globale posturologische und die traditionelle fasziale Denkweise.

Ein interessanter Ansatz ist es, diese beiden Denkweisen miteinander zu kombinieren. Denn die Faszienarbeit ist unvollständig, wenn man nicht das neuromuskuläre Gleichgewicht wieder herstellt. Ebenso ist das neuromuskuläre Gleichgewicht nur vollständig, wenn die Faszien frei sind.
